## What to do

To address the challenge of spoofing and robocalls, some carriers are proactively blocking phone numbers or marking them as spam if determined by industry rules. Unfortunately, this practice can flag legitimate phone numbers.

We share your concerns about phone numbers that are improperly reported and is actively working with carriers to refine the methods used to identify these calls.
